Category 1: Best All Natural Products (must be made from natural products such as wood, pandanus leaves, etc.)

Category 2: Best Recycled/Repurposed (must be made from all recycled or repurposed materials such as old plastic bottles, cans, paper bags, etc)

Will be judged on quality, relevance to the theme and creativity

- Open to all High Schools in RMI, LSA, Deaf Center
- 1 entry per homeroom/section per category
- The size of the model must be no larger than 36" x 24" (3 feet by 2 feet)

All entries will be shown and judged at the Jambo Arts Show on April 27th at Jitak. Judges will be local experts in the following fields: art, climate science, costal management, education and national political leaders.

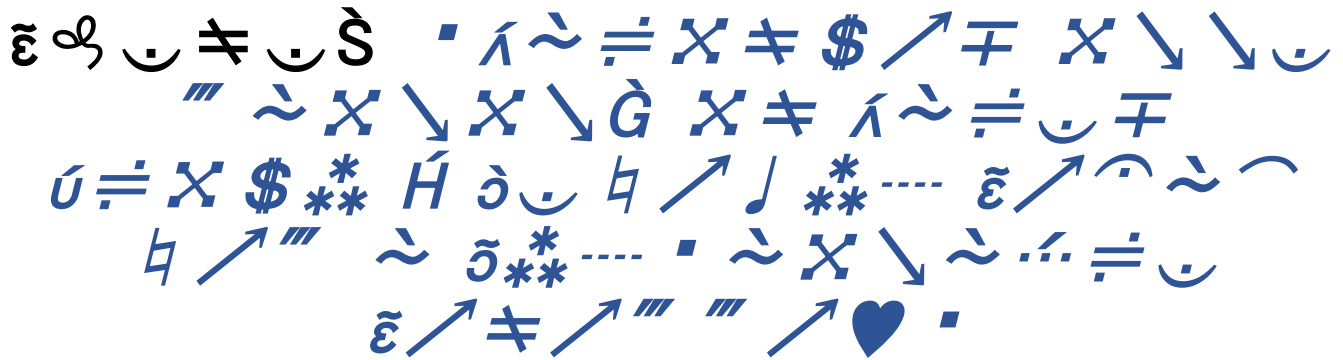
